The City Manager has selected John Skeel to fill the position of Director of Animal Services effective November 5, 2021.

With over 20 years of public sector management and executive experience throughout the United States, Mr. Skeel brings a wide breadth and depth of leadership experience that will complement the current Animal Care staff.
