## **Section 303(C)(6) REMOVE IN PERSON VOTE**

Mail Ballot Only Option in Case of Special Election. If a vacancy in the office of an Elected Official is to be filled utilizing a special election that is not consolidated with a scheduled federal, State or local polling place election, the City Council may authorize such election to be conducted wholly by mail ballot.

## **Section 602(D) ALLOW NON CITIZENS HOLD PUBLIC OFFICE**

Eliminate the requirement that most board and commission members be “qualified electors” (i.e., U.S. citizens), and instead requiring City residency with some exceptions. The City Council may appoint non-Residents to boards and commissions where expressly allowed under this Charter.

## **Section 1204 BYPASS VOTE OF PEOPLE FUTURE CHANGES TO CHARTER**

The City Council may enact additional rules or regulations, either by ordinance or resolution, as appropriate, in order to implement some or all of the terms of this Charter, provided that any such rule or regulation shall be consistent with the terms of this Charter.



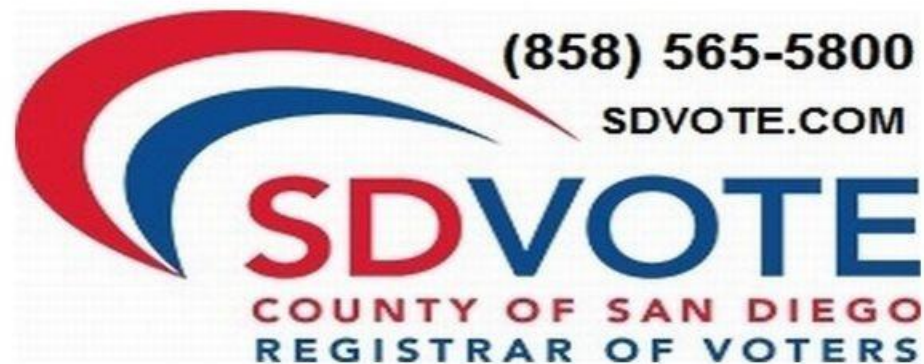

(b) The distribution of vote by mail ballots to all registered voters does not prevent a voter from voting in person at a polling place, vote center, or other authorized location. **(Must be registered IN PERSON VOTER)**

**VOTE IN PERSON MEANS CAST A VOTE WITHOUT ENVELOPE AT VOTE CENTER OFFICIAL BALLOT BOX**

**For voters who trust nothing but paper ballot (a wise decision)  
MAIL BALLOT MAY BE USED AS IN PERSON PAPER BALLOT PLACED  
WITHOUT ENVELOPE AT THE VOTE CENTER OFFICIAL BALLOT BOX**

Voters may vote at an location in their county. Vote Centers have an electronic data base connected in real time to county voter rolls and history. The vote center can check any voter name if the ballot has been received by the elections office. If ballot not received voter is qualified to vote in person. It is wise to take your mail ballot and envelope with you as proof that you have not voted in person. **KEEP ENVELOPE**
