- A. Height regulations in the R-3 zone and R-3-M, R-3-T and R-3-G classifications are as follows: No principal building shall exceed either two and one-half stories or 54 feet in height and no accessory building shall exceed either two stories or 25 feet in height, except as provided in CVMC 19.16.040 and 19.58.022.
- B. Height regulations in the R-3-H and R-3-L classifications zone are as follows: No principal building shall be less than 4655 feet or five stories in height and no accessory building shall exceed either two stories or 25 feet in height, except as provided in CVMC 19.16.040.
