Closure may be extended at the City Manager's discretion.

Total of 184 completed surveys were collected.






Survey Results -Demographics


Who Responded?

Represented Zip Codes




Represented Ages in Household










If you indicated "yes" to reopening the park on a temporary basis, the times you are most likely to use the park.



If the park was reopened on a temporary basis, what amenities would you use?






