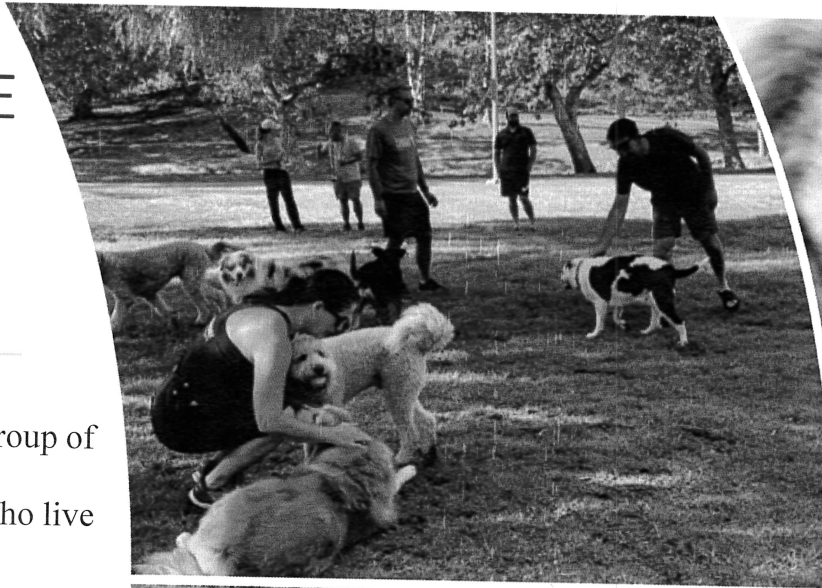
LEASH FREE ZONE AT HILLTOP PARK

- Healthy and Vaccinated dogs



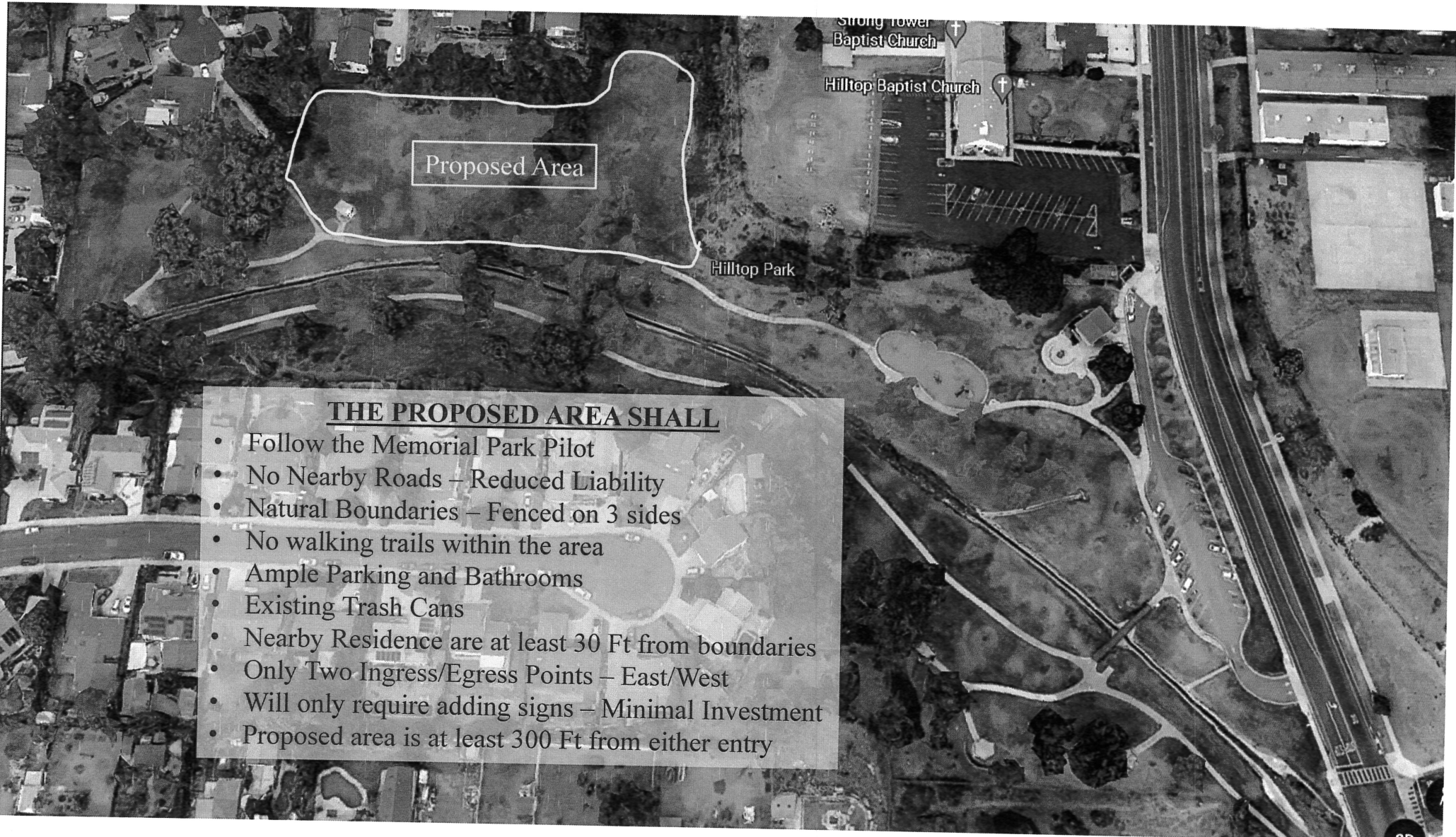
Fenceless Dog Parks promote Healthy Communities

- Fenceless Dog Parks promote strong commanding (Come, Stay, No!)
- Fenceless Dog Parks promote Trust among dogs and owners
- Seeing well behaved dogs in the community encourages new participation
- Obedient dogs don't bark excessively and promote peaceful communities
- Obedient and well socialized dogs are less likely to be aggressive (source 1 below)

- Trusting Dog/Owners relationship promote mental health (source 2 below)

THE PROPOSED AREA SHALL

- Follow the Memorial Park Pilot
- No Nearby Roads – Reduced Liability
- Natural Boundaries – Fenced on 3 sides
- No walking trails within the area
- Ample Parking and Bathrooms
- Existing Trash Cans
- Nearby Residence are at least 30 Ft from boundaries
- Only Two Ingress/Egress Points – East/West
- Will only require adding signs – Minimal Investment
- Proposed area is at least 300 Ft from either entry
