WHEREAS, based on the number of officers in the agency, the Police Department has been allocated \$163,585.26 from the California Board of State and Community Corrections for the Officer Wellness and Mental Health Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, these grant funds are designed to improve officer wellness and expand mental health sources; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department plans to use this grant funding to hire an hourly Public Safety Wellness Coordinator, host wellness events with motivational speakers, attend wellness/peer support training, purchase fitness equipment, and fund television cable services for the employee wellness room; and

WHEREAS, the grant period is from July 1, 2022 to December 1, 2025 and the fiscal year 2023/24 appropriation is \$83,781 and the fiscal year 2024/25 appropriation is \$79,804.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it hereby accepts \$163,585.26 from the California Board of State and Community Corrections, amends the fiscal year 2023/24 budget and appropriates said \$83,781 to the Police Grants in the State Grants Fund for the Officer Wellness and Mental Health Grant.
