Mitigation Activities

- City teams and contractors are collecting trash surrounding dumpsters at multi-family complexes.
- Contractors from Work for Hope and Alpha Project are assisting crews.
- Crews worked overtime Saturday to continue clean-up efforts.
- City is establishing an email and phone number to report overflowing trash.
- Recycling and yard waste bins will be placed in four locations. One in each Council district.
- City continues to coordinate with Republic Services to help with efficiencies to reduce the pile-up of trash in the community.

Mitigation Numbers: Wednesday - Friday

- City tackling a list of 500+ multi-family complex locations throughout the City to pick up overflow trash
- Deploying 5 8 vehicles
- 30+ staff and contractors
- 54,500 pounds collected
- 197 multi-family sites cleaned

- If there is a delay in trash and/or recycling pick-up, please leave cart(s) at the curb until picked-up
- Please remove carts from the curb once they have been serviced
