A set of principles/procedures according to which something is done in organized framework or method and/or a set of things working together as parts of a mechanism interconnecting network.

Bright-star (B1)

(Live Camper/Trailer/or Vehicle)

No drug or psychological issues or concerns, reputable job, go getter, positive attitude, easy to work with, highly desired to perhaps fast track for possible candidate for community or even city assistance (meaning) to help the Community or City

B2) Same as above the only difference not too open to being a factor for city or community.

Super-Star (S1) Live

(Live Camper/Trailer/ or Vehicle)

Extremely talented, working towards the betterment of those who are striving to make a real connection and movement with the like minded individuals in the community and/or City Government with incredible and Innovative Ideas and Energy.

Diamond-Star (D-1) - (Live/Camper/or Trailer

No drug or psychological issues or concerns, Decent Full Time Job. Educated, talents span across many fields.

Gold-Star (G-1) – (Live/Camper/or Trailer)

No drug or psychological mental concerns, strong, able bodied, full time job that is adequately paid. Some College education.

<u>G-2</u>

Part time job position, minimal education
(High School Graduate). Eager attitude, needs direction.

Silver Star

General decent attitude, some what skill, minimal alcohol/drug usage, solid mental state, willing to work hard. Minimal family/friend assistance.

S-2

No family, no friends, lives in car or streets

Bronze Star

Father with partner living on the streets, working, minimal substance usage with children. Currently in school with a part time job. Can not afford adequate housing.

Bronze 2-

Single Mom Unmarried w/children and possible partner. No substance abuse or minimal mental concerns. On government assistance. Needs help with day care, transportation, and afterschool programs.

Pearl Star - P 1

Young to elderly, disabled, no mental or social concerns, lives in car or on streets, has a form of income, possible job, willing to work or go to school.

Pearl Star 2- P 1

Young to elderly, disabled, no mental or social concerns, dlives in car or on streets, has a form of income, possible job, willing to work or go to school. Receives SSI or SSDI.

Red Star-1

Men who have drug addictions, drug abuse mental or psychological issues may have social concerns. Possible sexually transmitted disease or other types of disease or virus no job lack of education and lives on the streets.

Red Star - 2

Women who are drug addicted, drug and or alcohol abusers, mental issues, social concerns, sexually transmitted disease or other. Possible pregnancies.

Cron Star

Chronically unhoused known to manipulate the system and other benefits, push baskets or other type of conveyances, also avid recyclers, possibly sexually deviant, socially awkward, regularly steal or thieve, usually run in packs, live in groups or tents, might also have criminal records and or actively be on the run. Strong mental concerns need immediate Rehab and or other Social Programs.

This rating system is for the betterment of the advancement of each individual experiencing homelessness and prohibited from being similarly utilized in any way except by the expressed or written consent of C.R.A.P.
