RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CHULA VISTA APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE  
AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO FOR  
CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN THE CALIFORNIA  
IDENTIFICATION SYSTEM REMOTE ACCESS NETWORK

WHEREAS, since 1990, the City of Chula Vista's Police Department has participated in the California Identification System Remote Access Network, commonly known as Cal-ID/RAN; and

WHEREAS, Cal-ID/RAN is primarily used by the Police Department for booking arrests or identity verification; and

WHEREAS, the Cal-ID system is maintained by the State Department of Justice, but the County of San Diego is the responsible agency for system allocation and funding; and

WHEREAS, the current Cal-ID agreement will end on June 30, 2024, and the City wishes to amend the agreement to extend City's participation in CAL-ID for a two-year period ending on June 30, 2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it approves the amendment to the Agreement for Participation in the California Identification System/Remote Access Network (Cal-ID/RAN) Agreement Amendment, between the City and County of San Diego, in the form presented, with such minor modifications as may be required or approved by the City Attorney, a copy of which shall be kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk, and authorizes and directs the City Manager to execute same.
