RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CHULA VISTA ACCEPTING GRANT FUNDS FROM CALIFORNIA FOR ALL ANIMALS VIA UC DAVIS, AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2024/25 BUDGET, AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, Chula Vista Animal Services previously applied for and was awarded a grant through California for All Animals via UC Davis in the amount of \$53,000; and

WHEREAS, Chula Vista Animal Services applied for and has been awarded additional grant funds through California for All Animals via UC Davis in the amount of \$50,700; and

WHEREAS, the additional grant funds are intended to be used to provide pet reclaim financial assistance, a tag engraver, tags and collars for adopted and reclaimed dogs, and marketing funds; and

WHEREAS, the agreement permits funds from the grant awarded FY22/23 to be used toward reclaim fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chula Vista, that it:

- 1. Accepts grant funds from California for All Animals via UC Davis in the amount of \$50,700.
- 2. Approves an amendment to the Fiscal Year 2024/25 Other Grants Fund Budget, appropriates \$50,700 in the other grant fund to the Supplies and Services and Other Expense categories, and increases the revenue budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Manager, or designee, is authorized to take all necessary action to administer, monitor, manage, and ensure compliance with the program including certifications made in the application, and further to enter into and execute contracts, including contracts with third parties to implement the program or use of the funds, as appropriate.
