“ Director Castaneda has a financial interest in the Authority’s contract decisions related to the Project,” the FPPC’s July 24th advice letter states. “Director Castaneda must disqualify himself from any participation or attempts to influence all future decisions concerning the Project,” the letter concludes.

two government law attorneys La Prensa San Diego spoke with concluded **that having a conflict of interest going forward means Castaneda had a conflict when he voted on the contract last year, thereby invalidating the agreement.**
