In Calendar Year 2024, our HIDTA Executive Board approved raises for several Chula Vista management positions to include the HIDTA Deputy Director, Imperial Valley Law Enforcement Coordination Center (IV-LECC) Director, The IV-LECC Deputy Director, the San Diego Law Enforcement Coordination Center (SD-LECC) Deputy Director and the HIDTA Financial Manager. All these management positions are tied to Federal General Schedule (GS) per the HIDTA Executive Board at various levels and will go to the next step in their respected schedules except for the HIDTA Financial Manager who is not currently eligible. The SD-LECC Director, who is also tied to GS schedule and was hired in 2025 will also go to the next step within his classification level. These positions are not eligible for city step increases nor city cost of living adjustments. Each year we provide the federal salary rate, and any step increases for which they might be eligible.

Recently, the Federal GS Schedule increased 2.21% for the San Diego locality and 2.17% for the Los Angeles-Long Beach locality (El Centro). We request that the 6 positions be reclassified within the Chula Vista payroll system based on the current year 2025 GS Schedules by locality.
