Chula Vista businessman Alan Cassell was sentenced

to two years of probation after pleading guilty to one count of conspiracy concerning programs receiving federal funds in a judgement from the United States District Court District of Nevada filed on June 22. Cassell appeared in court on June 16.

Cassell was originally indicted in 2017 and pleaded not guilty. That same year he resigned his post as board member at Third Avenue Village Association citing personal reasons.

Cassell and six other defendants were accused of directing payments to Sergio Barajas, a one-time director of the National Community Stabilization Trust, a non-profit that used federal funds to restore foreclosed properties that were lost in the 2008 housing crisis.

As alleged in the indictment Cassell, doing business as Heartland Coalition and Ignition Ventures, paid Barajas about \$185,025 in exchange for receiving about 626 NCST foreclosures and made about \$2.8 million from resale of those properties.

According to court records, Cassell pleaded guilty in March as part of a group plea agreement.

- **Alonso Gonzalez, a newly appointed Chula Vista City Council member, has had a string of business, personal and financial hardships that were not disclosed when he applied for the position.**
- According to public records, Gonzales has an outstanding tax debt, a conviction for driving under the influence and foreclosed property. State records also indicate that the licenses for two businesses in his name are suspended.
- **The 46-year-old real estate broker** took the [oath of office](#) this week to fill the District 3 seat, but his background prevented him from receiving a unanimous City Council vote for his appointment.

School district paid \$9,788 for teacher Inzunza's cell phone use

- Inzunza made the most calls, more than 500, to family friend and political consultant Marco Polo Cortes. His brothers, National City Mayor Nick Inzunza and San Diego City Councilman Ralph Inzunza Jr., were also frequently called, as was his father, former National City Councilman Ralph Inzunza Sr.
- In those two years Inzunza made and received more than 1,600 calls between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. – nearly one-third of them after midnight

- There were calls to Tijuana, Mexicali,
- Miami, New York, Las Vegas and Wisconsin, and numerous calls to home and cell phone numbers in the Los Angeles area.
- Dozens of calls were made on holidays including Christmas, Easter and Thanksgiving, and numerous calls on weekends and after working hours to businesses that were not school-related or blurb advertisers,
- including movie theaters, restaurants, video rental stores, auto repair shops, music stores, hotels and nightclubs.

Inzunza Accepts Mater Dei Position

All good things must come to an end. After twelve years at Saint Augustine High School, Mr. Inzunza is leaving for Mater Dei in Chula Vista to become the Assistant Principal of Student Safety and Discipline.

It is a bittersweet moment for all of us because Mr. Inzunza has been involved with the Saints community in so many different roles as a student, a teacher, and ASB Moderator.

As a Saintman of the class of 1991, he served as ASB class president, lettered five times, was a part of the Saints band, and even started a skate club. He and The Rivals were part of a rock band that was hired by Saints, OLP, and other schools around San Diego. He was a socially and globally aware student, writing an article for The Augustinian that protested the first Iraq War (Desert Storm) and called for a walkout. While no one else participated, Father John Sanders joined him, and the two shared their thoughts on world affairs.
