
### District History & Overview

- Originally Established in 2001, the PBID was renewed in 2006 as well as in 2016.
- ▶ PBID Expires in December 2026 but requires the renewal campaign to be completed by Summer 2026.
- ► FY25 Operating Budget: \$902,871.64
  - ▶ 40% District Revenue Comes from Non-Assessment Income
- Provides daily, seven-day-a-week coverage
- Maintains Assets & Amenities in Downtown
- Organizes the Annual Taste of Third Program, Lemon Festival, Dia de los Muertos, and is a partner with the City on the Starlight Parade.



## Highlights This Past Year:

- ► Finalized Assignment of District Administration to DCVA from TAVA.
- Worked with City Staff to Source Estimates to Repair Downtown Landmark Sign.
- Successfully rehabilitated over 42 sidewalk gardens and 8 median planters installed by City.
- Continued to Expand Movable Table & Charis Sets to Third Avenue.
- ► Finalized the Deployment of Twelve Corner Planters Throughout District.
- Oversaw weekly Farmer's Market, as well as the growth across all events in Downtown Chula Vista.
