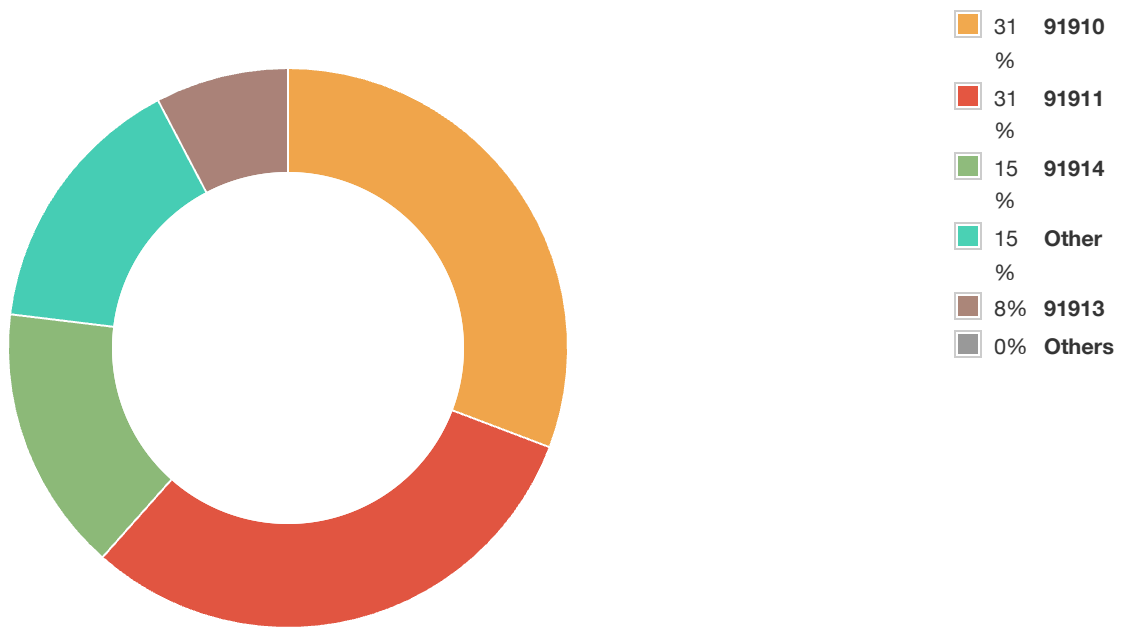

2. What is your business's zip code?



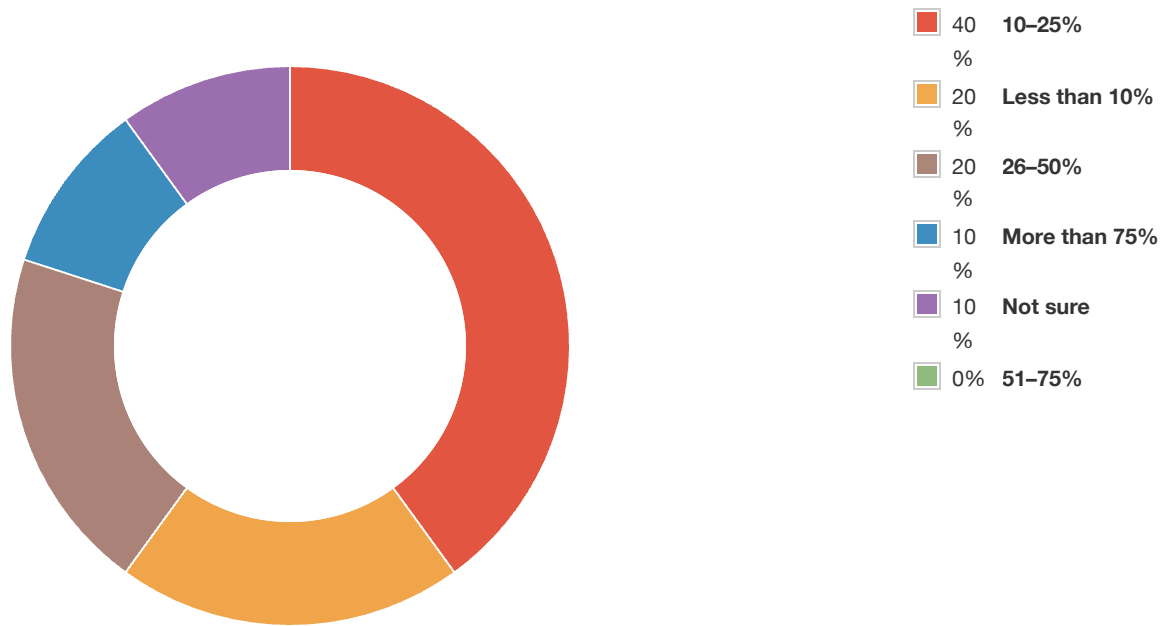

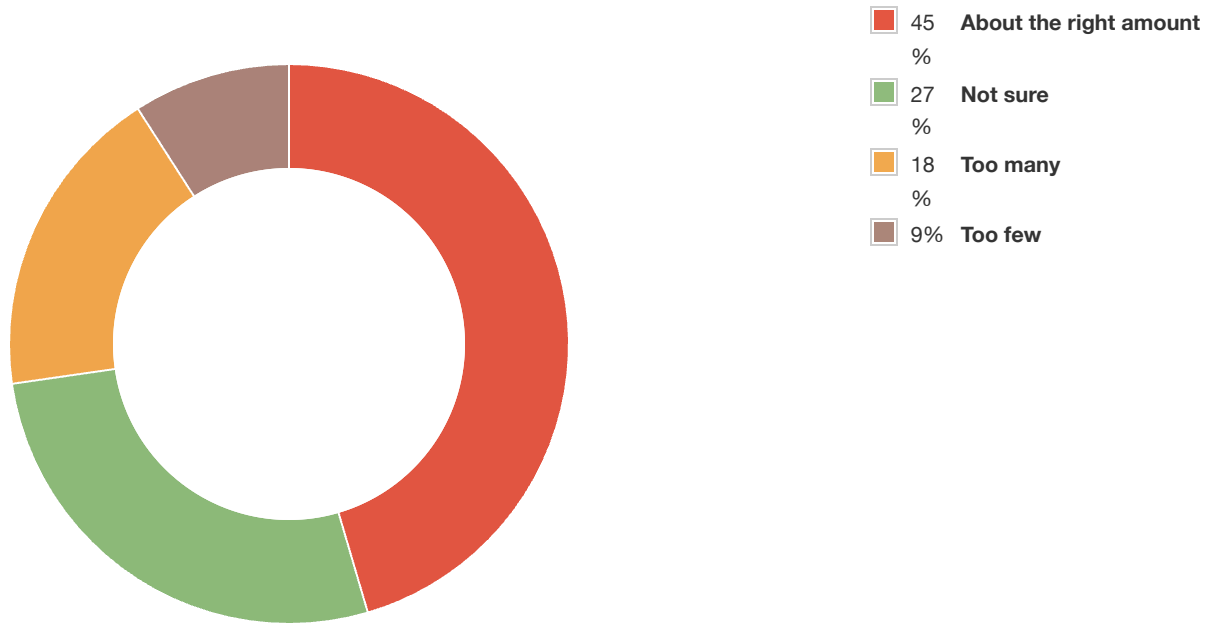

4. Approximately what percentage of your total sales come from tobacco or vaping products?



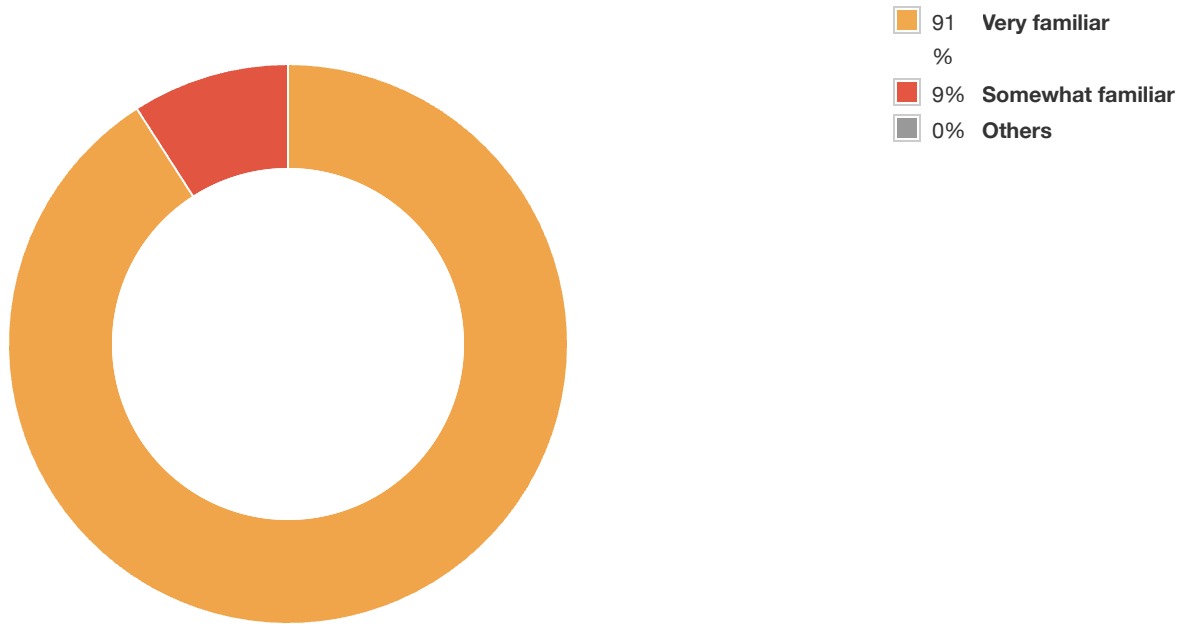

5. How would you describe the number of tobacco or vape retailers in your area?



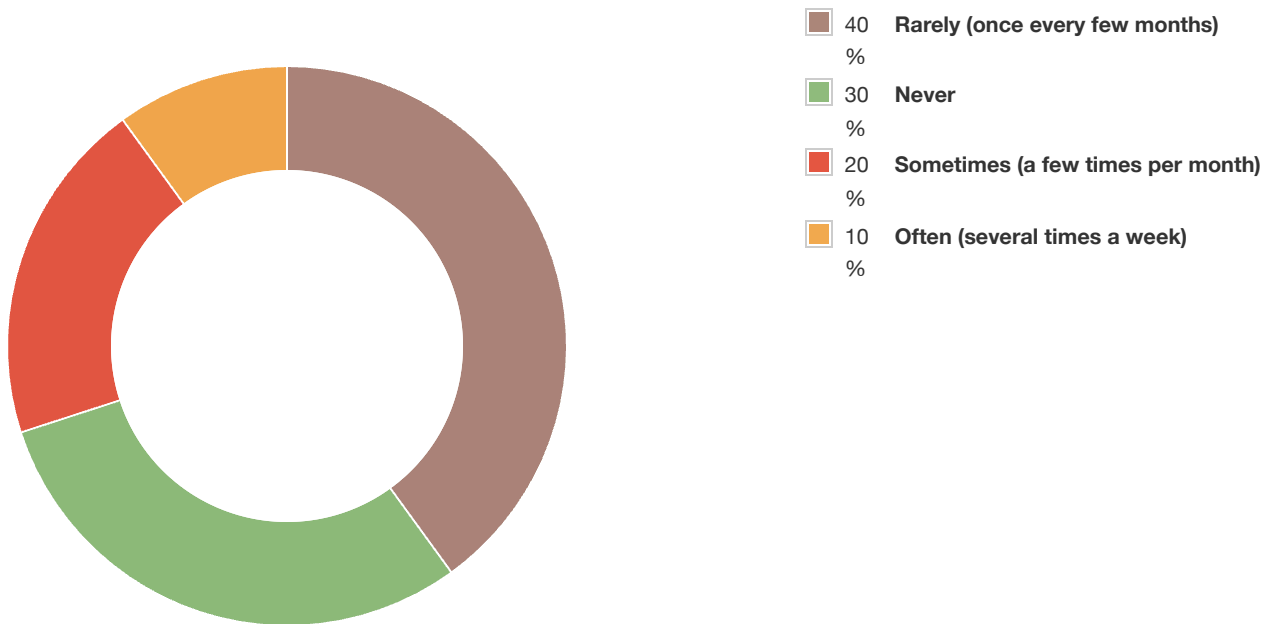
